Publication of a vacancy for the position of Executive Director of ECCC - the European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and Research Competence Centre, hosted in Bucharest

The European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and Research Competence Centre (ECCC) was established by Regulation (EU) 2021/887, in Bucharest.

ECCC has the overall objective of promoting research, innovation and deployment in the area of cybersecurity in the European Union. As of the year 2023, ECCC will have a staff of 53 people and will manage a budget of about EUR 200,000,000.

The European Commission published a vacancy for the position of ECCC Executive Director Temporary Agent - Grade AD 14 - COM/2022/20080. This is a senior management position to lead a multidisciplinary team of professionals, called to support a key priority area for the future of the European Union.

The Executive Director shall be appointed by the ECCC Governing Board, from a list of candidates proposed by the European Commission, following the selection procedure managed by the Commission.

The closing date for registration is 6th of September 2022, 12.00 noon, Brussels time.
